Bookings

You can enrol on a language course online via the <u>Say it in Dutch website</u> by using the enrolment form. Enrolment stops two weeks before the beginning of the course.

We will confirm by email, so don't forget to give us a valid emailaddress! In this mail you will be asked to pay a deposit of 10 % plus registration fee. Please note that full payment is required if you are reserving your course less than 4 weeks before your course starts.



Payment

Payment should be completed at least 2 weeks before you are due to start your course. We use Paypal because it is the most convenient way for these kind of international transactions, even if you don't have a creditcard.



Cancellation

If there are not enough participants for a course, we have to cancel it. We will let you know this about 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ weeks in advance of the date. Of course we will return your payment immediately.

If you cancel your enrolment yourself, please note these rules and regulations: Cancelling until 4 weeks in advance: no additional costs. We will return your deposit; Cancelling from 4 until 3 weeks in advance: 25% of the remaining cost of the course; Cancelling from 3 until 2 weeks in advance: 50 % of the remaining cost of the course; Cancelling less than 2 weeks in advance: 100 % of the remaining cost of the course. Of course you can send a friend to take your place. Please inform us about his or her personal details immediately!
